When it comes to jobs that are either too big, too hard, too time consuming, or out of your comfort zone, consider hiring a professional.

Insulate water pipes to prevent freezing	<input type="checkbox"/>	Clean eaves troughs and downspouts to ensure proper drainage.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Test your furnace, clean the burners and lubricate the pulleys.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Water-test your roof and flashing for leaks	<input type="checkbox"/>
Check heat-duct and water-pipe insulation.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Scan for damage outside of your home, including cracks or storm damage, and repair as needed.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Inspect any washing machine and dishwasher hoses for cracks or leaks, and clean the filters.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Caulk window trim and door frames.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Learn the location of, and how to use, the water shut-off valve should you need to shut off the water.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check your roof and flashing. Repair as needed.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have the furnace and air conditioner professionally serviced annually and repaired (or replaced) as necessary.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Install weather stripping on exterior doors and windows.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have any chimneys cleaned annually and repaired as needed.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Winterize your pool or hot tub.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Add or replace worn weather stripping around doors and windows to reduce air leaks and keep water from getting in.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn off the water supply to outdoor taps and leave the taps open to drain completely. Leave the taps in the open position until spring.	<input type="checkbox"/>
		Clear snow away from the foundation of your house throughout the winter. If the ground is sloped 0.65 centimeters per 30 centimeters near your house, moving the snow 1-1.5 meters from your foundation will reduce problems.	<input type="checkbox"/>
